Campbelltown Camden DCC Men's Cricket Round 8 v Mosman CC Grades 1-5 – One Day International Format

Campbelltown Camden District Cricket Club lost all five tosses on the weekend and found themselves bowling first in all grades in the SCA Round 8 fixture against Mosman CC.

In First Grade the Ghosts managed to reel Mosman back in after the visitors got off to a solid start. Visiting Tasmanian batsman Mark Cosgrove and his opening partner took full advantage of the placid Raby#1 wicket. They posted 140 for the opening partnership in fairly rapid time.

The Ghosts held Mosman to 262 after 50 overs when at one stage the locals looked like chasing well over 300. Damien Mortimer took 2-40, Luke Webb 1-27, and Scott Coyte 1-37. Josh Clarke also bowled tightly finishing with 1-14.

Unfortunately the Ghosts fell 30 runs short when batting despite looking promising before the tail was exposed. Josh Clarke (76 runs) and Ryan Gibson (36 runs) continued their great form this season. Both have been impressive batting at the top of the order. Clarke played a full range of shots and was unlucky not to score his second century for the season.

Skipper Scott Coyte looked like he was set to steer the Ghosts home. After batting patiently for an hour to compile 37, Coyte was dismissed when the score was 215. The remaining three wickets were unable force the ball and the Ghosts surrendered for 232.

2nd Grade travelled to Allan Border Oval, Mosman and found themselves in the middle of a “nightmare”. The Ghosts second grade bowlers had a tough morning and at the completion of the Mosman 50 over innings the score was a mammoth 6/405.

The Ghosts batsmen were determined to accept the challenge on the small ground. Jayden Simmons played superbly for 80 and likewise Nicky Craze for 50 not out however, the Ghosts innings closed after 50 overs at 8-265.

4th Grade were dismissed for 158 after being set 8/238 by Mosman in the morning. Whilst youngsters Jack Bray (3/58) and Tristan Ross (2/35) bowled superbly, the highlight of the innings was a tremendous catch by skipper Jamie Malskaitis. Mitch Taylor was the pick of the bats scoring 48 runs.

5th Grade on Raby #3 restricted Mosman to 8-150 from their allocated 50 overs and then passed them 6 wickets down in the 43rd over. On the back of some great bowling by Luke Courtney 3/43, veteran Todd O'Keefe's innings of 88 not out, in conjunction with Saad Hasan 63 not out, got the Ghosts home after a very shaky start. At one stage the Ghosts were 5-37 with the top order back in the shed until the 120 partnership between O'Keefe and Hasan. The most senior of the Ghosts players O'Keefe, like fellow left hander 1st Grader Josh Clarke, is having a great season.
